

Kaiser Permanente Washington Family Medicine Residency offers three Sub-Internships for 2024

\$3,000 scholarships sponsored by Washington Permanente Medical Group

RPrIDE - Residency Promoting Inclusion, Diversity, and Equity - is a faculty-led group focused on improving the health of our communities by addressing race discordance between family physicians and their patients.

The RPrIDE Visiting Student Sub-Internship is offered to medical students from backgrounds that are historically under-represented in medicine (URiM). Students spend 4 weeks in Seattle learning in inpatient, outpatient, and community health settings. RPrIDE faculty serve as student mentors. Up to three students per year will be selected for this opportunity, which includes a \$3,000 scholarship award.

APPLICANTS MUST BE

- In good standing, in their 4th year of medical school
- Interested in Family Medicine and interested in practicing in Washington state
- Able to participate in a 4-week Clerkship in Seattle during one of these timeframes:

Aug 19 - Sept 13, 2024 September 16 - October 11, 2024 November 18 - December 13, 2024

• From groups under-represented in medicine (URiM). For the purposes of this program, we define URiM based on race/ethnicity discordance between the Washington State population and the number of family physicians. In Washington, Black/African American, Hispanic, Latino, Native American, or Asian Pacific Islander and other Asian ethnicities are underrepresented in medicine.

- Letter from Medical/Osteopathic school stating current academic standing
- Medical/Osteopathic school transcripts (unofficial will be accepted)
- Resume / CV
- Two letters of recommendation (not from family):
 - ✓ one from a medical/osteopathic school professor/clinician
 - ✓ one from an advisor or activity leader who can speak to your work in diversity/inclusion activities or culturally competent care
