Clinic

800 patient panel of three years

4 half days/week at the beginning of intern year (4 visits/visit)

2 half days/week by the end of R3 year (2 visits/visit)

Medicine

R1: Six 2 week assignments of Day and 1 week of nights, with the 1st attending

R2: Six 2 week assignments of Day and 1 week of nights, with 1st and 2nd attendings

R3: Three 2 week assignments of Day, with the 1st attending

Obstetrics

30-40 12-hour shifts per year, all three years

Scheduled 2-4 shifts in a row

Geriatrics

10P 4 half days/year

Palliative Care 2 half days/year

Respite 2 half days/year

Home Visits 2 half days/year

Peds UC at KP 23 shifts

Peds ED at SSM 4 weeks
